"A Trip to Nenagh", irisch "Turas go dtí An tIonach" ['tʉrəs go dʒi: ʔən 'ti:nəx], deutsch "Eine Reise nach Nenagh", ist ein Progressive Column Dance in Triple Minor Proper Column Formation, mit Free Hold und Face-to-Face Configuration, Lady rechts des Gents, für drei Paare. Er wird zur gleichnamigen Hornpipe, zu den Slip Jigs "Andrew Carey" oder "The Piper's Maggot" oder zu beliebigen Hornpipes oder Slip Jigs im Belfast-Stil getanzt. "A Trip to Nenagh" besteht aus 6 Bewegungen in 32 Takten als Hornpipe oder 16 Takten als Slip Jig.
